Ljubljana is the capital and the largest city of Slovenia. It has been the cultural, educational, economic, political and administrative center of independent Slovenia since 1991

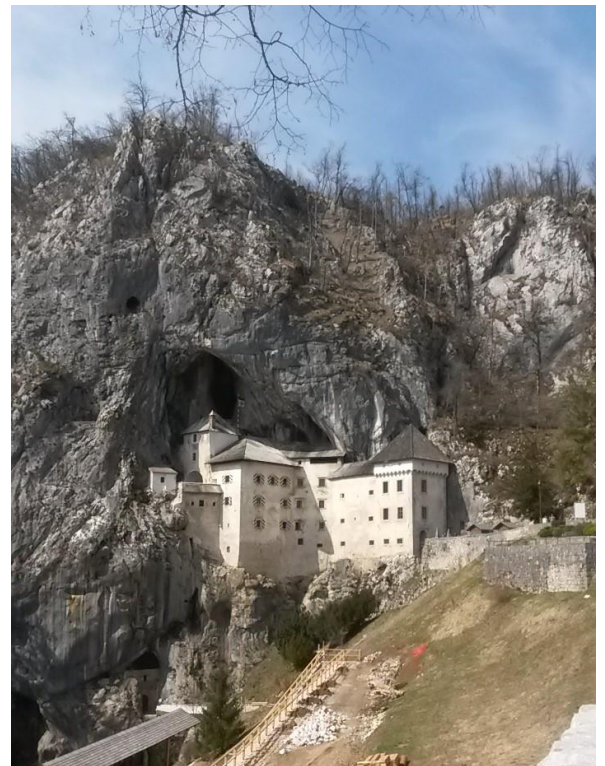
The symbol of the city is the Ljubljana Dragon. It is depicted on the top of the tower of Ljubljana Castel and on the Ljubljanica-crossing Dragon Bridge. It symbolizes power, courage and greatness.





Postojna Cave is a 24,120 m long karst cave system near Postojna. The caves were created by the Pivka River.

Predjama Castle is a Renaissance castle within a cave mouth. The castle became known as the seat of the knight Erazem Lueger, lord of the castle in the 15th century and a renowned robber baron.



Celje Castle is a castle ruin in Celje. It stands on three hills, where the river Savinja meanders into the Lasko valley.



Bled Castle is one of the oldest castles in Slovenia. The image of the castle towering above the lake and its romanic island and church is the attraction that has earned Bled worldwide fame. The castle buildings spread across two courtyards, which lie on different levels.
